It's that time of the year again. The 2018-19 rugby season is approaching fast. It's time to renew your membership of Currie Rugby Football Club.

Renewing your membership could not be easier: cash, credit card, or cheque can be presented over the bar with your membership card, if no details have changed. If you elect to pay by Standing Order your discount benefits will be reinstated or membership card issued once the first payment has been received.

I hope you will complete and return your forms by the end of July and in plenty of time for the first matches of the season.

At the end of July bar discounts will cease until your membership is paid for the coming season (excepting for Life Members). You will still be able to use credits on your bar card, but without discount.

This year Members wishing to apply for International tickets will be able to do so on forms that will be sent out separately.

Youth Player Registration forms will be sent out directly from the Youth Committee.

Introduction

Currie RFC offers a range of membership types designed to meet the needs of individual club members. Multiple memberships, may also be purchased as Family Membership packages. The types of single memberships and related benefits are set out below.

The club's membership year runs from 1 August to 31 July. Full-year memberships may be taken out or renewed from July onwards.

Payment for memberships may be made in a single payment, by cash, by credit card (both at the Club bar) or by cheque. Payment may also be made in four monthly instalments by Standing Order on 31 August, 30 September, 31 October and 30 November. Standing Order payments cannot be accepted after 30 November.

Spouse/Partner Membership

A Spouse/Partner membership can only be purchased together with an Ordinary membership. It has similar benefits to an Associate membership but match entry concessions may be interchanged with those of the Ordinary member, permitting the Spouse/Partner to gain free entry to matches that the Ordinary member does not attend.

Family Memberships

Family memberships provide multiple memberships consisting of an Ordinary member, Spouse/Partner member and youth members in the P1-P3 and P4-U18 age groups, either playing or non-playing.

The pages that follow provide Membership application forms with fee rates for:

- (a) different types of Membership and Family Memberships
- (b) Visiting Memberships
- (c) a Standing Order Mandate.

Data protection

This information will be held on the Currie RFC Membership Database and may be used to facilitate contact between members of the Club. If this application form relates to a Youth Membership then the responsible adult signing this form consents to this information being shared with the particular Youth team Coach and Manager for the purposes of contacting team members and for contact in case of an emergency. Members must inform the Membership Secretary of any future changes of the details provided. The Membership Secretary will remove lapsed members details before the next time their membership is due for renewal.

The details on this form will be used for Club purposes only, as explained above. Where the membership involves playing for, coaching or managing a Currie Chieftains team then some or all of these details will be shared with the SRU through their registration database.

Consent is also given to being contacted by e-mail or 'phone and that any photograph taken at a game or event, which includes those recorded on this form, can be used on the Club website, in the match day programme or in promotional material.

Privacy policy (part 1)

What we need

Currie RFC Ltd. trading as Currie Chieftains will be a “controller” of the personal information that you provide to us in this form, unless otherwise stated.

When you register as a member of Currie Chieftains or renew your membership (including if you are registering or renewing on behalf of a child under the age of 16), we will ask you for the following personal information:

- contact details – name, address, email address, and date of birth;
- membership category

Why we need your personal information – contractual purposes

We need to collect our members’ personal information so that we can manage your membership. We will use our members’ personal information to:

- provide you with core member services, including, insurance, licensing and PVG checks;
- set up your membership account and administer your account; and
- send you membership communications by email in relation to essential membership services, including but not limited to, membership renewals and information on membership benefits.

If you do not provide us with all of the personal information that we need to collect then this may affect our ability to offer the above membership services and benefits.

Why we need your personal information – legitimate purposes

We also process our members’ personal information in pursuit of our legitimate interests to:

- promote and encourage participation in the sport of rugby by sending members’ communications and booking information for upcoming competitions and events. Our competitions and events may be filmed or photographed and your personal information may also be used in images captured from our competitions and events, which we use for promotional, education and development purposes;
- provide competition in the sport of rugby by accepting and managing entries for our competitions and checking your personal information to ensure you are entered into the correct category;
- develop and maintain our members’ qualifications, including sending email communications to members to inform you of upcoming courses, renewal requirements and verify that you have completed any mandatory training and PVG / child protection requirements; and
- respond to and communicate with members regarding your questions, comments, support needs or complaints, concerns or allegations in relation to the sport of rugby. We will use your personal information to investigate your complaint, suspend membership and take disciplinary action where appropriate.

Where we process your personal information in pursuit of our legitimate interests, you have the right to object to us using your personal information for the above purposes. If you wish to object to any of the above processing, please contact the Membership Secretary on membership@curriechieftains.org. If we agree and comply with your objection, this may affect our ability to undertake the tasks above for the benefit of you as a member.

Why we need your personal information – legal obligations

We are under a legal obligation to process certain personal information relating to our members for the purposes of complying with our obligations under the Protection of Vulnerable Groups (Scotland) Act 2007 to check that our coaches and volunteers are able to undertake regulated work with children and vulnerable adults. We’ll need the following, Name, Signature, Date and if U16 form must be signed by Parent or Guardian.

Privacy policy (part 2)

Who we share your personal information with

We will only share your personal information as outlined below.

We may be required to share personal information with statutory or regulatory authorities and organisations to comply with statutory obligations.

Such organisations include the Health & Safety Executive, Disclosure Scotland, and Police Scotland for the purposes of safeguarding children.

We may also share personal information with our professional and legal advisors for the purposes of taking advice.

As an affiliated club of Scottish Rugby we are required to ensure that all of our playing and coaching members are members of Scottish Rugby as a condition of affiliation. We will share your personal information with Scottish Rugby who will become a controller of your personal information when they receive it.

Storage and security of personal information

We will strive to ensure that personal information is accurate and held in a secure and confidential environment. We will keep your personal information for as long as you are a member or have regular contact with us or so long as we are obliged to keep it by law or may need it in order to respond to any questions or complaints or to show that we treated you fairly. We may also keep it for statistical purposes but if so we will only use it for that purpose. When the information is no longer needed it will be securely destroyed or permanently rendered anonymous.

Getting a copy of your personal information

You can request details of the personal information which we hold about you by contacting us using the contact details given below.

Inaccuracies and Objections

If you believe that any information we hold about you is incorrect or incomplete or if you do not wish your personal information to be held or used by us please let us know. Any information found to be incorrect will be corrected as quickly as possible.

You have the right to object to our use of your personal information, or to ask us to remove or stop using your personal information if there is no need for us to keep it. There may be legal or other reasons why we need to keep or use your data, but please tell us if you think that we should not be using it.

If we are processing your data on the basis of your explicit consent, you can withdraw your consent at any time. Please contact us if you want to do so.
